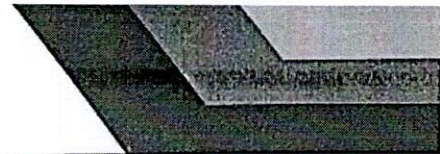

This helps students to fill the knowledge gap between academia and industry. The two parties to this MoU, with the intention of both being legally bound, accept the following terms and conditions:

#### 3. Responsibilities of SIT

The SIT shall

- a) Provide the following minimum infrastructural facilities:
  - i. Computer lab with High speed internet connectivity

#### 4. Responsibilities of Epitas:

The Epitas shall:

- a. Provide certified mentor(s)
- b. Provide basic kit and accessories to implement and innovate new products.
- c. Purchase project kit (student specific) on cost reimbursement basis
- d. Guide and encourage students to build their academic project modules on emerging technologies.
- e. Develop and provide training materials.
- f. Provide certificate on successful completion of projects.

#### 5. Force Majeure

In the event of non-fulfillment of the contract terms and conditions due to any reason of force majeure namely fires, wars, riots, strikes, natural calamities, etc., neither Epitas nor SIT shall be held responsible for any loss or consequential loss.

#### 6. Indemnity

The SIT hereby agrees jointly and severally to indemnify Epitas, their representatives, administrators and properties from and against all action, demands, proceedings, prosecutions, and the like arising out of its liabilities and all charges, taxes, etc.

Similarly, Epitas shall be liable to indemnify/compensate the SIT on account of any losses arising due to the fault of Epitas.

7. The SIT shall ensure that all its software is legal. Epitas shall not be responsible in any way for any liabilities arising out of use of pirated software.

8. Epitas will be one of the authorized parties for patenting the products developed at the innovation center along with SIT.

#### 9. Breach of Agreement

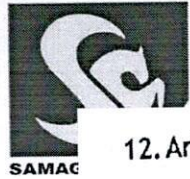
Epitas shall have the right to terminate the agreement with the SIT, in case the SIT either fails to provide the mutually agreed services successfully as mentioned in the MOU, or exploits the students or misuses the partnership with Epitas in any way.

#### 10. Amendment to the Agreement

The obligation of the SIT and Epitas have been outlined in this agreement. However, during the operation of the agreement, circumstances may arise which call for alteration or modifications of this Agreement. These modifications/alterations will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing.

#### 11. Period of Validity

This agreement shall be initially valid for two years from the date of signing the agreement and to be renewed subsequently by mutual consent of both the parties.



## 12. Arbitration


Any dispute arising with regard to any aspect of this Agreement shall be settled through mutual consultations and agreements by the parties and /or it should be in the jurisdiction of Mangalore only.

## 13. Pricing


Epitas encourages students to enroll for certified internship program via Epitas google form. This internship program will have the nominal fee of Rs 6,000 per month plus GST as applicable. Every student have to pay this amount directly payable Epitas account

Epitas would be happy to share a margin of 15% on each internship registration fees (Excluding GST) collected from SIT students and the payment of 15% amount will be considered as rental fee which will be paid before 15<sup>th</sup> of consecutive month (this 15% is inclusive of all taxes). If there is no internship fees collected during any month, no rental fee is payable. If Epitas conducts workshop, seminars etc for SIT students, this margin may vary or not applicable as per the mutual discussion.



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this day of 06-10-2018 between two parties namely Department of Microbiology, University College (Institute - I), with registered address as University College, U.P. Malya Road, Hampanakatte, Mangaluru, D. K., Karnataka, India

AND

Department of Nano Technology, Srinivas Institute of Technology (Institute-II) with registered address as Srinivas Institute of Technology, Srinivas Campus, Valachil, Mangaluru, D. K., Karnataka, India

Department of Microbiology, University College (Institute - I) and Department of Nano Technology, Srinivas Institute of Technology (Institute-II) are referred as the "Parties" or individually as "Party".

Whereas

- a) University College (Institute-I) Mangalore, which came into existence to cater to the educational needs of the marginalized sections of the society of Mangalore, has stood the test of time for over 148 years. The Government of Karnataka handed over the College to Mangalore University on 1993 with the name 'University College'. University College has been accredited with "A+" grade by NAAC. It has also received a "Heritage Tag" as the college is about to complete 150 years and recognised as "Centre for potential excellence" by UGC.
- b) Srinivas Institute of Technology (Institute-II) was established in 2006 with the aim of producing world-class technology graduates tuned to the demands of a fast changing global village. SIT has gained the name as the best, self financed, engineering college in Karnataka in terms of infrastructural facilities. Srinivas Institute of Technology (SIT) is a unit of Srinivas Group of Colleges, Mangalore and is affiliated to Visvesvaraya Technological University (VTU), Belgaum, India and recognized by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi, India. The Institute is located at Srinivas Campus at Valachil.

**Purpose:**

The Parties recognise that there exists a significant set of common shared values, missions, goals and constituencies of their organisations.

This MoU articulates the intentions of the parties to work cooperatively and does not create any legally binding commitments.

The objectives of the MoU are:

1. To assist and guide the students for projects and their research leading to PhD.
2. To conduct seminar, symposium, workshops conference, etc. with mutual collaborations.
3. Field visits to know the departments and the activities.
4. As per the convenience, concerned authorities' regular meeting to review the progress and activities of both the departments is suggestive.
5. To organise other activities of mutual academic interest for the students.

**Administrative Terms and Conditions****Financial Liability:**

This MoU will be done without any financial liability on either side. However, the Parties are at liberty to approach funding agencies, independently or jointly, which may provide them funding. **Declaration:**

**Conflict of interest:**

In the event of any dispute arising in respect of any provision of this MoU, the Parties shall make every reasonable effort to resolve all issues fairly by mutual negotiation. Any dispute, which cannot be settled amicably, shall be referred to the Head of the Department of both the Parties.

**Term:**

This MoU shall be effective from this day 06-10-2018 and shall continue in force for a period of five years. Any extension of the term shall be subject to the mutual written agreement of the Parties.

**Amendments:**




**Termination**



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**CloudE**, having its Registered Office 2687/2, 5th Cross, Kalidasa Road, VV Mohalla, Mysuru - 570002, Karnataka (hereinafter referred as "CloudE"):

SIT and CloudE shall be hereinafter be collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party"

WHEREAS

- A. **SRINIVAS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, Mangaluru** is specialized in providing value-added, holistic engineering education to students at affordable costs, in conducive academic ambience, leading to Personality development and intellectual growth.
- B. **CloudE** is a fast growing IT solution entity working from two platforms, one aiming at training solutions and the other at product solutions. CloudE Product Solutions Arm (CPA) offers product solutions and consulting services in Embedded, Software Testing, Software/Hardware Product Development, Web Designing Java, Android and many other domains relevant to the industry.
- C. The Parties wish to co-operate with each other as per the terms and conditions enumerated in this MoU.

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES SET FORTH THEIR PRELIMINARY UNDERSTANDING AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Scope**
  - 1.1 The scope of this MoU is to provide a framework of reference to build a strong and on-going relationship between **SIT** and **CloudE** in various areas of mutual interest and benefit.

1.2 The primary goals are:

- Impart practical-oriented training, tailored for industry needs following hybrid
- model of top-down and bottom up approaches
- Create an atmosphere for the self-learning of the subject, one is most interested in
- Grooming students to be industry ready
- Assist students in placement
- Provide industry
- Provide standard guidance for project works
- Performance evaluation and Interview pre-screening

2.1 SIT and Cloude will establish a "Core Consulting Team". Both the Parties shall ensure that the "Core Consulting Team" comprises of appropriate personnel from both parties to discuss and implement the ideas. Both sides will also have Single Point of Contact for coordinating various activities and for administration purpose.

2.2 SIT shall be represented by Principal along with the team of designated faculty members as and when necessary.

2.3 Cloude shall be represented by Mr. Mahesha Padyana, Founder & Chief Executive Officer

2.4 The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that "Core Consulting Team" will meet at least once in three months (every quarter) to ensure successful implementation of all programs mutually agreed to in the areas mentioned in this MoU. Dates are to be decided by mutual consultation.

3. Responsibilities of SIT:

- a. To provide necessary laboratory and class room infrastructure with Hardware, Software and a designated Faculty In-charge for conducting the program.

- b. To identify and make available interested students internally as desired by SIT to participate in the program.

4. Responsibilities of CloudE :

- a. To provide industry experts as resource person for the training programs.
- b. To train SIT students on best industry practices and develop competency in one or more of topics such as Basic Computer Science and C or C++ Programming for beginners, Advanced C or C++ Programming with Integrated Software Engineering, Hardware Design, Embedded System, IoT, PCB Design, Software Engineering, Software Testing and test automation, Java Programming, Android programming Database: SQL Server, MySQL Administration, Oracle Architecture ASP, Data Structures, Project Management, Web Design and development, HTML, XML, PHP, Python and Perl Scripting Automation, Robotics, VLSI etc at minimal cost in the SIT campus.
- c. To work with SIT and industry to bring in more consulting / campus recruitment opportunities.
- d. To work closely with industry to provide support in advanced training in software testing with latest software tools for UG (CSE, ISE & ECE) programs of SIT.
- e. To allow students to carry out UG/PG Projects / Internships as per University regulation. The number of students and projects/internship will be decided based on mutual convenience.
- f. To bring additional kits, boards and other technical infrastructure for conducting the program at reasonable price.

5. Joint responsibilities of SIT and CloudE

SIT and CloudE jointly agree:

- a. To closely work together to bring paid Workshop/Training opportunities for Colleges nearby. The workshops will be technically supported by CloudE. Travel and accommodation of the trainers/trainees will be taken care either by college or CloudE decided on case to case basis.



- b. If any project carried out in a joint venture leads to a potential Product/service, then incubation centre terms and conditions will be laid down on CloudE
- c. In case of additional funding required to develop expertise on consulting, SIT and CloudE to put up joint project proposal for funding by govt or any other agencies.
- d. To work towards success of projects and relationship fostering
- e. To enter into a separate non-Disclosure agreement to safeguard and protect each other's data confidentiality and other interests.

## 6. Terms and Termination

6.1 This MoU shall come in to effect from 01<sup>st</sup> day of June 2018, and shall remain in effect for a period of thirty six (36) months. After a period of thirty six months, MOU can be further extended on mutual agreement.

6.2 Either Party shall have the right to terminate this MoU by giving ninety (90) days prior written notice to the other Party.

## 7. Confidentiality

7.1 Neither Party shall, without the prior written consent of the other Party disclose to any third party the contents of this MoU or any information obtained by either Party in performance of or in connection with this MoU. The Parties agree to take all reasonable measures to maintain the confidentiality of all Information which in no event will be less than the measures it uses to maintain the confidentiality of its own information of similar importance.

7.2 The obligations of confidentiality shall come into effect upon the signing of this MoU and shall survive even after the termination of this MoU.

## 8. Commercial

The commercial for each consulting/Training opportunity shall be:

- I. Training fee structure will be fixed by both the parties.
- II. The Cost for the Board/ Kits /other training materials shall be charged to the students and upon completion of the

Program, training material shall be handed over to the institution to create their own lab. (The training fee shall include this cost).

III. The minimum strength of students required to run the On Campus Training Program is 40 students per program and maximum strength shall be 60.

IV. Taxes applicable as per the Government on the fees

V. Food & Lodging Facility for CloudE Experts during training will be provided by CloudE.

## 9. Intellectual Property Rights:

9.1 This policy assures that the intellectual property arising from this agreement is used in the best interest of both parties.

9.2 SFT will give the right of first refusal for the Fore ground Intellectual Property developed via this MOU to CloudE. In case CloudE is not interested in acquiring this IP, SFT would be free to use the IP as deemed fit by SFT.

9.3 SFT, its employees and the faculty / students are protected and indemnified from all liability arising from the development, marketing, or use of the particular intellectual property by CloudE.

9.4 Both Parties shall retain their respective rights with respect to any equipment, methodologies, tools and technologies provided here under for the purpose of this MOU. Both Parties will ensure that such equipment, methodologies, tools and technologies are used solely for the purpose set out in this MOU.

## 10. Arbitration

10.1. In the event of any dispute or differences arising at any time between the Parties hereto as the construction, meaning or effect of this Agreement or any clause or thing contained herein or the rights, duties, liabilities and obligations of the Parties hereto or breach thereof, the parties shall in good faith endeavor to resolve the dispute by mutual discussion. In the event, the parties are unable to do so, the matter will be settled by arbitration subject to the provision of the Arbitration and

Conciliation Act, 1996 and as amended from time to time. The Parties agree shall mutually endeavor to appoint a single arbitrator, within a period of thirty (30) days upon being called upon to do so. In the event, the Parties fail to appoint a single arbitrator, by mutual agreement, each Party will appoint one arbitrator and the two arbitrators so appointed will appoint a third arbitrator to whom the dispute will be referred for resolution. The arbitration proceedings shall be in English and held in Coimbatore and in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 and as amended from time to time.

#### 11. **Governing Law and Jurisdiction.**

11.1 This MoU shall be governed by the laws of Republic of India. Any dispute arising in connection there with shall be submitted only to the Courts in Mangaluru, India.

#### 12. **Non Solicitation**

12.1 SIT shall not directly or indirectly solicit, or cause to be solicited the employment of any employee of **CloudE**, who is involved in the performance of its obligations under this MoU.

#### 13. **Binding**


13.1 This MoU shall be binding on the Parties.


13.2 The Parties hereby acknowledge that this MoU is confined to the general terms agreed between the Parties for mutual co-operation.


